1. VACCINATION

- (1) Vaccination is not compulsory and is carried out with the consent of the recipient and the parent. For the implementation of inoculation, refer to the information on the website of the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare.
- (2) We don't carry out mass inoculation at kindergarten school.
- (3) If you cannot go to school due to vaccination, please follow the instructions below.

- 1 Late arrivals and early departures for vaccination will be considered as attendance.
- 2 If you are absent for a day due to vaccination, it will be treated as "suspension of attendance" instead of "absence".
- 3 If you cannot attend school due to side effect after vaccination, it will be treated as "suspension of attendance" instead of "absence".

Please understand the following (1) & (2) at home so that discrimination and bullying will not occur due to receiving or not receiving the New COVID-19 Vaccination.

Vaccination is not compulsory, it is voluntary, and we do not say or act to force vaccination to others.

Some people may not be vaccinated for physical or other reasons or may not want to be vaccinated. Also, that judgement should be respected.
